When I arrive, I can enter from any side of the City Green where the concert is located and find a spot to set my blanket or chair. I can do many fun things on and around the City Green.

I can visit the **Activities Tent** (pink flag) and participate in making art or moving with an artist.

I can walk to the **green** flag to find the **Information Tent** if I have questions. I can also ask questions of any JMKAC staff who are wearing matching colored Levitt AMP T-shirts.
