The Lunch Break: Arts/Industry in Between exhibition celebrates the special kinship between factory associates and resident artists. The work featured exemplifies the cooperative learning that takes place in the factory. David Ross Harper (Pottery, '12 & '14) will discuss his series of mask-like

forms titled *A Fear of Unknown Origin*. Harper will touch on the process of mold making, lessons learned in the factory, and how the work came to be.

Visitors can explore these ideas through hands-on activities, such as sewing and casting, utilize techniques and materials used by artists and medical professionals alike.

Slip Cast Demo with Arts/Industry Technician Nicole Woodard Saturday, October 26

2:00 – 4:00 p.m.

Ever wonder how artists and artisans create ceramic ware at Kohler Co.? Join Pottery technician and artist, Nicole Woodard, as she demonstrates the slip casting techniques used by Arts/Industry artists in the Kohler Co. Factory. Learn tricks of the trade while you watch clay go from a liquid to a solid within minutes by using special molds and processes. Nicole will also walk through various finishing techniques, factory resources, and offer expert insight into some of the works on exhibit.

Mad Dash: Artist Talk with Tom Uebelherr

The *Mad Dash* exhibition showcases work created by Arts/Industry residents over the program's fifty-year history. Artist Tom Uebelherr (Foundry, 1993) will discuss his work, *Pink Barrel Stove*, and the story behind each detail.
